

LUTHERAN CHAPEL COUNCIL MINUTES JUNE 9, 2019

The next scheduled Council meeting is on Sunday, August 11, 2019 at 5:00pm in the conference room.

The Council made decisions and discussed the following items:

- A motion unanimously passed to fund \$785 mission trip fundraising shortfall from the Robinson Fund.
- A motion passed unanimously to welcome and reinstate membership for former member Anna Cleveland Purvis.
- A motion passed unanimously to cancel Living Lutheran at the end of the church paid subscription. Members may request continuation of individual subscription at church expense.
- Brotherhood has approved \$2,000 seed money for an electronic church sign. A volunteer team is in place to review options and to make recommendations to the congregation.
- Church bell repairs and Family Life Center Light replacement projects will continue to move forward.
- Church Endowment Committee elected officers: Chris Angstadt, Chair; Nancy Witman, Recording Secretary; Drew Carpenter, Financial Secretary.
- Church accessibility committee added two members and is meeting with contractors to review ideas.
- Revenues as compared to expenses year to date through May 31, 2019 reflect a positive balance of \$11,179.53, suggestions and existing plans for accessibility project.


LOVE OFFERING FOR THE MONTH OF JULY IS TO HOUSE OF MERCY






NEW PRAYER MINISTRY TEAM MISSION STATEMENT


