We are a priesthood of all believers (1 Peter 2:9-10), let us each do the work God would have us do during these days to love and help one another.

Most ministries are shut down among us in obedience to our local and state governments and in hopes of not spreading the contagion. So, no church office hours, Dirty Collar Workers, Preschool, AA group, Clothes Closet, and church committees can function now. A few do continue with texting and Zoom meetings. However, there are two ministries that are continuing. First, our Outreach team continues to distribute backpacks to Robinson Elementary to help the families we were assigned there. Second, our Social Ministry continues to collect canned food and non-perishable items to support Crisis Assistance Ministry. If each of us can share some food and place in the blue box located outside the entrance to the Education Building when you do your household grocery shopping, then hopefully we can support this local effort to help our neighbors in crisis.

#### LUTHERAN CHAPEL COUNCIL MINUTES MARCH 8, 2020

The council made decisions and discussed the following:

- \$32,443.73 has been received toward electronic sign to date. Approximate installation date April 23 or 24 with electrical work and permitting to take place prior to installation.
- A motion unanimously passed to purchase a new desk top computer and monitor for the office and laptop for Pastor utilizing recommended memorial funds.
- A committee has been formed to explore ideas for Chapel improvements.
- A motion unanimously passed for a new color copier for the church office and continued use of existing copier in the conference room.
- Accessibility needs continue to be addressed with Ken Obenauf and Ed Robinson chairing a new committee which includes 7 members. Two local contractors have been contacted for this.
- Lutheran Chapel is in need of a church historian to preserve our stories that are part of life together, including pictures of youth and elderly. Council suggested several members to serve in this role. Pastor will contact.
- Council discussed options and suggestions to block sides of stage when family life center while pulled out for use. These ideas will be taken to property committee for additional investigation.
- Revenues as compared to expenses year to date through February 29, 2020 reflect a negative balance of \$1264.35.

The next meeting is scheduled for Sunday, May 3, 2020 from 5:00pm – 6:30pm. This is a combined April/May meeting due to Easter and Mother's Day.

and our community, ministries such as **Crisis Assistance Ministry** continue to help our neighbors in need of food. We have placed the blue CAM box under the drive through outside the office. If you are able, please continue to place non-perishable items in this box and it will be checked every couple days and delivered to Crisis Assistance Ministry. Some items in need are – pancake mix and syrup, cereal, canned fruits, meat, soup and vegetables (no green beans or corn), spaghetti and sauce, grits, oatmeal, rice, crackers and personal care items. We realize that shopping can be complicated at this time, however, if you are able to pick up (or order if you are having

your groceries delivered) a few extra items to place in our donation box, it would be greatly appreciated as CAM struggles to meet the needs of those who do not have the money to grocery shop. Thank you so much!
