From the Pastor...

There are a number of initiatives that are underway as we move into the waning days of the Covid-19 pandemic. They are in the areas of facilities, families/young adults, fellowship, and worship. A brief summary is below with more to be shared in a Congregational Meeting on Sunday, June 20.

Facilities

The Accessibility Project to add bathrooms and to make the sanctuary accessible without navigating stairs is a big goal. The principle of hospitality demands we work towards making all the church campus as accessible as possible for all of us and for all whom God may bring to the mission here. Other areas of interest include aesthetic improvements and lighting in the Memorial Chapel and a plan on how to best use the property adjacent to the pavilion. It is important for us as a fellowship to make a plan and work it towards such goals.

Families/Young Adults



There is a large number of church members between the ages of 35-50 who are sporadically involved. After Covid-19 and a season of disconnection, how might we reconnect as followers of Christ and support one another? There are several efforts that will be going on through the summer leading into the fall. A young adult supper club that is just starting, a modified Vacation Bible School June 17-19 (for all ages actually), a quarterly

fellowship for Sprout families (July 25 for a time of kickball and fellowship is the first), and various outings that are in the planning stages are some things to note.

Fellowship

Again, recognizing this season of disconnection, specific actions to reconnect among all our fellowship are an important part of life together. There are a host of ideas towards this goal. To eat together with a fellowship meal one night a month that may include bringing in a speaker of interest from the wider community, a common hands-on ministry to work on together, and a game night for fun is a goal. Crafts (like we did for



the Advent season before the pandemic), outside worship and a social with tents erected and food served – the focus is on encouraging one another as the people of God in this time and place.

LUTHERAN CHAPEL COUNCIL MINUTES MARCH 14, 2021

The Council made decisions and discussed the following:

- Amy Carpenter reported that modified VBS is a go. Currently having youth and members of MMO register. (June 17-19)
- There will be a Roots Car Wash Fundraiser- July 17th open to members of the church. There is a goal of \$500 raised for the backpack ministry.
- Pastor is offering Sunday School looking at the Psalter during the summer months. It is being held in the Family Life Center at 9:30am.
- Council approved having two credit cards distributed to Kim and Amy Carpenter. There would be a \$2500 limit on the master card, held by Kim, and a \$750 limit for Amy's card.
- Council approved the Chancel Choir returning the men and women to one side as long as they could still be safely distanced and choir members felt comfortable with it.
- Council received updates from the four sub-committees tasked with goals for leading the church into the future. Expects to have a congregational meeting discussing these goals on June 20.

The next Council meeting will be held in July.

As you can see from above, total receipts through April 30,2021 are \$105,712, while total year to date disbursements exceeded that number by \$897.00. This can be seen in the first column titled Actual Cash INCREASE/DECREASE. Receipts are typically soft during the summer months and these will pick up in months starting in September.

JUNE LOVE OFFERING

Lutheran Support Group of Gaston County

Our love offerings for the month of **June** will be for the Lutheran Support Group of Gaston which provides ongoing support for Faith Farm, Bess Town Road and Mountain Ridge Group Homes. A coalition of Lutheran Churches helps with maintenance and upkeep of these homes and works with Lutheran Services Carolinas and other agencies to provide the use of these properties owned by LSGG for needs in our community.

Mountain Ridge Group Home is currently operating in Gastonia. It is operated and owned by Lutheran Services Carolinas. It serves adults with developmental disabilities.

Faith Farm in Dallas had been serving as transitional housing for the rehabilitation of women veterans. However, the Veterans Administration made the decision to stop funding this project. Therefore, the facility was closed due to lack of funding. Currently, Mountain Ridge Group Home is utilizing Faith Farm as an extended facility for daily activities for their male residents.

The Bess Town Road property is still in the process of being renovated as a home for homeless male veterans. The facility will provide the men a home and enable them to eventually move to a home of their own. This property will be known as Camp Centurion – Gaston Barracks. The Lutheran Support group is working with Camp Centurion to use the Bess Town Road property. Camp Centurion is a non-profit agency whose mission is to provide local veterans who are experiencing a difficult transition from military to civilian life, with the essential secure environment, services and support they need to be able to finally "come home", regardless of the length of time since discharge. Supportive housing will be provided in a secure environment that is structured and supervised. Every veteran will have a personalized plan. There is not a definite date for the opening of this facility, however work is continuing at this property.

Your generous donations are greatly needed and appreciated as the ministry of these homes continue to serve the needs of our community.
