#### Sunday School: Five Gifts for the Children of God

Bible study and small group fellowship = Sunday School! This has been missing among us during the days of the covid-19 pandemic and the plan is to restart this crucial ministry for all age groups on Sunday, September 12. Reflecting on my personal journey, here are five gifts I've gotten from Sunday School as a child and youth.

Train up a child in the way he should go, even when he is old, he will not depart from it (Proverbs 22:6). Ten Commandments, golden rule, Lord's Prayer, memory verses, fruits of the Spirit (remember the poster with pictures of fruit and the gift listed along with it from Galatians 5:22-23) – these were all lessons passed down with art and flannel boards. I am thankful for all who poured God's Word into me and into each child. Where else will children learn these gifts? Let us teach each child among us about the gift of this cause and effect world and point them in the right way in a world full of mess.

#### The cheerful heart has a continual feast (Proverbs 15:15).

Put your mind on the cheer not on the tear. Rejoice in God's love, the good creation and in all excellent things (Philippians 4:4-8). I remember clearly singing "I've Got the Joy, Joy, Joy Down in My Heart" and the cheerful heart makes a difference.

#### God loves a cheerful giver (2 Corinthians 9:6-15).

Anyone else remember the piggy bank lesson? Give (10%) to God's glory and to help others, save (10%) for the rainy day when needed, and spend (80%) wisely and have fun. I learned later as an adult another part to the lesson - from Proverbs 22:7 – avoid debt because "the borrower is slave to the lender." What might happen if Congress could learn this Sunday School lesson?

#### Make a joyful noise to the LORD (Psalm 100).

Singing takes our focus off us and focuses on the LORD. Jesus loves me this I know because the Bible tells me so! I also know it because we sang it. I always had a tough time with crafts (sadly more of a stick figure kind of guy) but that was part of the time together after music time. Anybody else thing music and art is still worth teaching?

For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life (John 3:16).

This is the #1 Bible verse from my memory. Later, as an adult, I learned Martin Luther called this the Gospel

in one verse. I am loved. I belong to Jesus. I trust Jesus now and this is leading to forever in Him. Or another song that was sung: "I am a C-H-R-I-S-T-I-A-N!" All people need to know God's love for them. So, these lessons, and there are many, many more, begin to shape little ones to be children of the Heavenly Father and part of His mission to all the world.

Please consider coming to the Sunday School restart on Sunday, **September 12** at 9:30. If you are blessed to have children or grandchildren, invite them to come too.

Treasurer Report

Actual cash increased in the month of May to \$10,389.00. This increase in cash as stated in previous reports was primarily due to activity limitations of normal church ministries due to Covid. As you can see on Line 1 of this report from left to right actual giving as compared to budgeted giving is in a slight deficit (\$12,083.00). The results from this deficit is normal and can flow through the fiscal year tracking with the same results. From year to year, we may finish the year in a slight loss of cash. This happens but is just a course we take on any particular year. When we return to normal activities in the fall, we will be able sustain our ministries without any significant burden. The summer months will reflect slight downward movement of our contributions but this is very typical for our church year cycle. Historical giving revenues will pick back up in the fall.

The Church's balance sheet reflects strong equity position to meet any unforeseen shortfalls or unforeseen repairs we may have during our church year. We have been truly blessed here at Lutheran Chapel for the faithfulness of our church family and their gifts.


