Seder Meal

Maundy Thursday, April 14 ~ 6:00pm

Family Life Center



Moses said, "Thus says the Lord: About midnight I will go out through Egypt. Every firstborn in the land of Egypt shall die, from the firstborn of Pharaoh who sits on his throne to the firstborn of the female slave who is behind the hand mill, and the firstborn of the livestock. Then there will be a loud cry throughout the whole land of Egypt, such as has never been or will ever be again. But not a dog shall growl at any of the Israelites—not at the people, not at animals—so that you may know that the Lord makes a distinction between Egypt and Israel.

The Lord said to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt:Tell the whole congregation of Israelthey are to take a lamb for each family... without blemish....they shall eat it roasted over the fire....This is how you shall eat it: your loins girded, your sandals on your feet, your staff in your hand; and you shall eat it hurriedly. It is the Passover of the Lord.

These lines from Exodus briefly describe the Passover of God from the last plague issued to Egypt. Passover is the most holy of Jewish holidays and commemorations, and is exactly what Jesus and the disciples were doing in that upper room the night before the crucifixion.

Passover is more than a festival. It is an elaborate teaching experience intended to call people to their identity as the People of God. It is a way to confess faith in God who has acted in history for our benefit out of his boundless love.

Since the temple in Jerusalem was destroyed in 70 AD Jews celebrate the Passover in their homes with a Passover Seder. Seder is the Hebrew word for "order" or "procedure" because of the fixed order of the service.

On Thursday, April 14, also known as Maundy Thursday, from the Latin word "mandatum" meaning mandate or commandment, our Lutheran Chapel family will have a Christian Seder Meal at 6:00 in the Family Life Center We offer this service every other year on Maundy Thursday. The meal should not be considered a full evening meal as such but there will be plenty of food to eat. It is a meal which involves all 5 senses. The Seder is one of the most beautiful and meaningful services that we offer. It joins our Lutheran Chapel family with a 3000 year old community of faith, and is a very good way to prepare for the observance of Good Friday and the celebration of Easter.

One of Jesus' last earthy acts was the celebration of the Passover. Gathering His disciplesin a small room in Jerusalem, He led them in a Passover Seder, "I have eagerly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer." (Luke 22:15)

The Worship and Music Committee is putting together plans for our Seder Meal on Thursday, April 14, 2022 at 6:00PM in the Family Life Center. We need to get an approximate number to plan accordingly. LUTHERAN CHAPEL COUNCIL MINUTES March 6, 2022

The council made decisions and discussed the following at the March 6 meeting:

- A financial report was provided and it was noted that our financial standing through the first two months of the year is good.
- Wednesday evening services saw a decline in attendance during the month of February. The Wednesday evening services during Lent will be the more formal Holden Evening Prayer service.
- Calling lists are being organized to share with Council members.
- A new provider for the phone tree is being researched. Would like a service that can be initiated remotely with possible options to send text messages and emails.
- Council voted and approved to have Communion presented at the altar beginning Palm Sunday, April
 10.
- Council voted and approved to begin a one Sunday per month after church snack to be offered outside the Sanctuary, weather permitting.
- Protocols for a potential Activities Director for Lutheran Chapel is being investigated. This position
 was initially presented to Council as a potential goal during the 2021 calendar year by the Fellowship
 sub-committee.
- A one-day, all-day VBS for Lutheran Chapel children and friends has been proposed by the Christian Ed Committee for June 18.

Our love offering ministry for April will be Lutheran Services Carolinas. Lutheran Services is an agency of the North and South Carolina Synods of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America and is one of the largest non-profit child and family service agencies in the Carolinas, serving thousands of people annually through the following services:

- ◆ Adoption regular and special needs
- ♦ Adult Residential Services
- Child and Youth Residential Services
- Disaster preparedness and response
- Family and individual counseling
- Foster care family, therapeutic and medically fragile
- ♦ Homelessness prevention
- Refugee and resettlement and immigration
- Veterans services

LSC serves in **Gaston County** through foster care, services to people with developmental disabilities, its partnership in Senior TLC program and Dallas High School Apartments.

- Lutheran Services Carolinas has purchased the Dallas High School Apartments which provide 30 low-income Gaston citizens with a nice, comfortable, safe place to live.
- LSC is a founding partner of the Senior TLC Program for All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) which serves Gaston, Cleveland, and Lincoln counties now serving 240 low-income seniors in their homes.
- Mountain Ridge group home in Gastonia provides a safe home for six adults with developmental disabilities and six foster children have been placed in a safe home in our community.

Lutheran Services Carolinas works in partnership with congregations, governmental agencies, and other human service providers to promote healing and wholeness for the Carolinas' most vulnerable people.
