From the Pastor...

God's Word is given that we may pray the Word back to God (**Psalms: Prayerbook of the Bible**, Dietrich Bonhoeffer). Daily prayers, Holy Communion for millennia the Christian Church have used these Scriptures morning and evening, Sunday by Sunday. What does this Word say for us in 2024? How will the Holy Spirit grow us as we pray God's Word together?

Psalm 95:1-8 the *Venite* is the traditional morning Psalm to recite or sing. Others are 3, 5, 62, 63, 67, 100 and 102. Since the death of my Dad, the poetry and reverence of the New King James Version has been a blessing to me and a translation I am trying to put in my own heart. Consider the gift of God's Word below with some commentary to share.

Oh come, let us sing to the LORD! Let us shout joyfully to the Rock of our salvation. Let us come before His presence with thanksgiving; let us shout joyfully to Him with psalms.

For the LORD is the great God, and the great King above all gods. In His hand are the deep places of the earth; the heights of the hills are His also. The sea is His, for He made it; and His hands formed the dry land.

Oh come, let us worship and bow down; let us kneel before the LORD our Maker. For He is our God, and we are the people of His pasture, and the sheep of His hand.

Today, if you will hear His voice: Do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now, and will be forever. Amen.

- o Oh come Make the LORD your focus each morning He gives!
- o Shout We will shout for the Panthers. Shout for a sports game. Will we shout for God's goodness to us given day by day?
- o In His hand God is the maker of all that is and He reveals in His very Name, the I AM, that He is Present as He chooses from the depths of the earth to all the cosmos
- o We are...the sheep of His hand May we be led by our Good Shepherd in our families, work, this church, the community and in all things we do.
- O Do not harden your hearts This is a warning not to rebel and be hard hearted. Let us be tender hearted loving God and one another.

Let us put the Word in us abiding in Jesus by the power of the Holy Spirit to the glory of our Father in Heaven.

Council made decisions and discussed the following:


- As of 12/31 we will no longer be able to pay the Sunday Security police officer directly. It will need to be handled by a third party. Details are forthcoming.
- New Council members were welcomed Drew Carpenter, Peery Linkous, Seth Myers and Jenny Williamson.
- Council voted unanimously to not tithe the beneficiary money received from two different estates at this time.
- A motion was unanimously passed to receive Linda Hamilton into membership at Lutheran Chapel.
- Leadership was passed to Jason Sanders as Council President for 2024. Vice president will be decided in January. Crown Hoffman will serve as Past President, Debra Hoffman will serve as Secretary, and Ken Obenauf as Treasurer.
- Full Council meetings will continue to meet every other month with Executive Council meetings on the off months.

The next full council meeting, including new council members, is scheduled for January 21, 2024.
