THE FIFTY DAYS OF EASTER 2025

Easter is not just a day but a fifty day season. It is the Feast of feasts and lasts seven weeks. You may note the Bible is replete with "seven" as a symbolical number representing wholeness and completion.

So how do you feast for fifty days? I mean how do you balance a faithful feasting and celebrating without becoming unhealthy? Isn't it strange how virtues and vices may tumble into one another? I love apple pie. Too much apple pie is bad for me. But the right taste, right time, right is just so right! In excess, the wrong act, the wrong time, wrong is just so wrong! Make sense? Please share some ways you keep the feast in 2025.

Consider the resurrection hope. The One who gave us life in the beginning and gives us our very existence, who sustains us heartbeat by heartbeat, this One has been made known to us and the whole world in Jesus Christ. Jesus alone is the way, the truth, and the life – eternal life, resurrection life, and He calls all of us to hear and believe. What will the resurrection of the body be like? Early Christians pointed to the caterpillar becoming the butterfly. It is hard to accept that I am a caterpillar! I am not what I should be. My understanding, my reason is limited. My capacity, my personhood is in flux. Yet God is calling us forward to become what He wills for us ultimately to be as His children now and forever.

Christ is risen! He is risen indeed!...O Death, where is your sting? O Hell, where is your victory? Christ is risen and you are overthrown. Christ is risen, and the demons are fallen. Christ is risen, and the Angels rejoice. **Christ is risen, and life reigns.** Christ is risen, and not one dead remains in the grave. For Christ, being risen from the dead, has become the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep. To Him be glory and dominion unto ages of ages. Amen (**Paschal Sermon**, St. John Chrysostom).

Let us keep these 50 Days from Easter Day to Ascension Day to the Day of Pentecost this June 2. Come for little church – Evening Suffrages will be prayed at 7:00 then an episode of **The Chosen** watched together at 7:15 or so with discussion and fellowship. Celebrate!





LOVE OFFERING FOR MAY

Our love offering for May will be sent to Habitat for Humanity – Charlotte Region. In October of 2024, Gaston County consolidated with Charlotte Habitat, serving Gaston, Iredell and Mecklenburg counties. Habitat for Humanity is a non-profit Christian-based ministry founded in 1988 that is dedicated to eliminating substandard housing.

Funds for the construction of homes are obtained through financial contributions from individuals, churches, and businesses. The homes are sold to qualified families at no profit and financed with affordable, no-interest mortgages repaid over 20 years. Mortgage money is then recycled back to build more homes for families in need. Habitat is not a give-away program. Habitat relies heavily on volunteers for construction in all homes. The work is a cooperative effort between volunteers and new home buyers who contribute labor to build their homes.

To date, Habitat for Humanity of Gaston has built over 138 homes in Gaston County and completed homes in a neighborhood in North Belmont on donated land known as Dixon Village. Of the 28 homes completed, 12 are Habitat homes. There are three other active builds currently being completed in Gaston County. Also, Habitat for Humanity is launching a critical home repair program.

Please prayerfully consider giving to this ministry so that Habitat can continue to grow and help even more families achieve the opportunity to become homeowners.

Your baptism once, whether a baby or elder, is good forever because it is the gift of God and not your own action (Ephesians 4:4-5).


You have the ultimate mission – to do the will of our Father in Heaven here and now (Matthew 6:10).
