Our love offering for **September** will be given to the House of Mercy – a sponsored ministry of the Sisters of Mercy. The mission of House of Mercy is to provide care to persons living with advanced AIDS. This ministry cares and provides housing arrangements for those who cannot afford the costs. An environment of complete acceptance and love is provided in a home-like setting. House of Mercy provides a caring structure of regular meals, scheduled medical appointments, and medicines. The program offers individuals the opportunity to deal with spiritual issues and encourages family reconciliation when families are in disarray.

2025 marks the House of Mercy's 34th year of service for persons living with AIDS. Over 350 persons have made House of Mercy their home since 1991. Over the last 5 years, the residents are using antiretroviral meds and have improved lab results with 50% able to move on to independent living.

Without our donations, this ministry could not continue to exist because 80% of their operating budget comes from contributions. We ask that you please remember this ministry in your prayers and monetary offerings.


